



### **Tom Arntzen -Keyboards and Lead Vocals**

“A very good singer.” –Tom Jones

As an established artist in Vancouver, Tom wears many hats; vocalist, keyboardist, composer, arranger, producer, musical director, teacher, and actor. He can write, arrange, sing and play any style of music, and often does. He has released the albums “Everyday Love,” a collection of original spiritual songs, “The Turning,” featuring original jazz, and “Real Live Music,” a collection of children’s songs, two of which were recorded by Charlotte Diamond and Fred Penner.

Tom was music leader for the 2013 Grey Cup gala and played again in 2014. He sang with the VSO Pops at the Orpheum Theatre, accompanied Jack Jones at River Rock Show Theatre, and arranged and sang on numerous vocal sessions with Grammy winner Dave Pierce. He was featured vocalist and actor in the Showtime movie, “Reefer Madness” and was vocal coach to Will Ferrell in the movie “Elf”. Tom musically directed “All Grown Up” at Richmond Gateway Theatre, and the Jessie Award-

nominated “Red Rock Diner” at the Arts Club Theater. As a session musician, he has written, produced and sung TV and radio jingles for the Canadian, U.S., Japanese and New Zealand markets.

Tom is a featured artist in many lower mainland musical acts, performing at The Vancouver Club, Terminal City Club, Shaughnessy Golf Club, Royal Vancouver Yacht Club, Parq Casino, Fairmont Pacific Rim, Pan Pacific Hotel, Hotel Vancouver, Hyatt Regency, Four Seasons, Westin Bayshore, Delta Pacific Resort, Chateau Whistler, and many more, both for private parties and weddings, in theatres, ballrooms, pubs and lounges. He has played keyboards and sang on engagements for such corporate clients as Telus, Air Transat, Air Canada, Amway, Bausch & Lomb, Pfizer, Bayer, Bank of Nova Scotia, Western Tire, Rogers Video, IBM, and many, many more.

### **Adam Rohrlick - Electric Guitar & Tenor Saxophone**

Adam has performed with Michael Buble', Colin James, Kenny Wayne, Jim Byrnes, Mike Reno of Loverboy, Russell Malone of Diana's Krall's band and members of Wynton Marsalis' Jazz at Lincoln Centre Orchestra. He has also worked with the Dal Richards Orchestra, Mike Henry, Catherine St. Germain, Diane Lines, Babe Gurr, Cory Weeds, Kelly Brock, Dr. Strangelove, Neil Harnett, Acoustic Groove, City Soul Choir, Island Soul Choir, Vancouver Men's Chorus, and Gary Comeau & the Voodoo All-Stars.

As a recording artist and session musician, Adam has played on CBC TV's Triple Sensation and CTV's Canadian Idol shows, as well as numerous CD recordings and film soundtracks and live on CBC Radio One. He has performed extended engagements in Japan, Spain, Los Angeles, New Orleans, throughout Canada, and on cruise ships from Alaska through the Caribbean to New York. He has appeared in concert with Mark Hasselbach and the Jazz Perpetrators during the 1999 Vancouver International Jazz

Festival and at the Commodore Ballroom Octoberfests from 1993 to 1996 with Peter Juric & The Continentals. Adam was a regularly featured guest at the Yale's weekly blues Supersession from 1997 to 1999 and served as a judge for the B.C. Country Music Association's Talent Search and song writing in both 1997 and 1998. He also was a juror for the 2000 Juno awards. Adam performed at the Plaza of Nations with Jake and Elwood's Blues Brothers Revue during the 2001 World Figure Skating Championships and played BC Place during the Vancouver 2010 Winter Olympics for the BC Day Victory ceremonies. Adam is a member of the Swing Soul Band and in 2018 he also played guitar with the Vancouver Symphony Orchestra at the Orpheum Theatre for their performance of the soundtrack to the film La La Land.

In addition to his work as a sideman, Adam leads his own group called Hip Pocket which has performed on CBC Radio's Hot Air Jazz show, at the Vancouver International Jazz Festival, the Burnaby Blues Festival, the Whistler Jazz & Blues Festival, the CBC annual Food Bank Drive, the Terry Fox Run, BMO Vancouver Marathon as well as numerous public, private and corporate events including Terry Fox Run / C.B.C.
